Category Lists: Family Group Big Days

Here are state big day tallies for specific family groups. The number following the avian families represents the total non-vagrant species that could be found in Illinois. Some counts may not appear to be significant from a state perspective, but could represent the record for a specific region (i.e. northern, central, southern); some counts may represent the record for the season. A new state record was set last Fall, when the group of Fisher, Hughes, Jaconson, Kassebaum and Stotz together found seven species of Loons/Grebes - all but the Pacific Loon. The Northern Illinois record of five was tied this past fall. Also, a new mid-winter waterfowl record was set by Travis Mahan when he located 20 species -EW (updated 4/4/07; compiled by Eric Walters & Joe Lill)
