Month Lists: Top Three, Regional Top Five & County Big Months

All-time Illinois Big Months (top three per month)

Three new Big Month records were set in 2008, highlighted by Walters' 241 in May. He had broken his old record with a week to go, yet couldn't get to six regular breeding species and nine other rarities that spent more than a day at their found locations. He feels that a well-planned Big May by someone who can dedicate significant time to such an attempt could push this record to close to 260.

McMullen squeaked by his eight-year-old record, finding 140 species in March. As well, Walters bested the former November record, finding 149 species. It's interesting to see how the top three from November are higher than March, suggesting that bird variety could be higher in the former month, something that may be surprising to some. Of the other five new additions to this list, both Baum's August (180) and Stotz' September (195) stand out as they represent the second highest tallies ever achieved in those respective months. Since Big Months are very similar to Big Years, without the lengthy time commitment, this list could appeal to a larger variety of birders, especially those Big Year birders 'resting' between their annual attempts.
